The General Rules

All entries must be original work that is unpublished in any format and which has not won any other competition.

All entries must be typed clearly in plain font, single spaced on A4 paper. We regret that handwritten entries cannot be accepted. We would prefer a minimum of font 11 please.

If the entry contains several pages they must be stapled together.

All entries must be written in English. The title must be clearly typed on the top of the entry and must match the title given on the entry form.

The competition will be judged anonymously, therefore no marking identifying the author may be included on the entry itself, only on the entry form.

No single entrant will be awarded more than one prize.

Entry fee is £5 for each story entered.

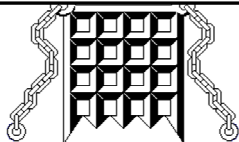
The judges decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

No entries can be returned.

As a rule of thumb, if your cheque has been cashed, you have been entered!

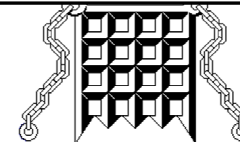

Rules for Entries

Short stories must be no more than 1,500 words. If the entry is over 1,500 words it will be disqualified.

Entries should be typed in plain text in either 11 or 12 font and single spaced.

Please use plain A4 paper.

Please head your story with the title used on the entry form. Do not write your name on the story, all judging is done anonymously.

Please include a word count at the bottom of your story.

This year the competition is an open one and entries may be on any subject of the author's choosing.
